Program: My Sisters' Place Position Location (full address): 566 Dundas Street, London, ON Time Commitment: One shift per week, 3-4 hours

Role Description and Primary Responsibilities:

- Providing encouragement and support to participants of the Micro Enterprise program
- Assist at public events and/or retail "pop up" events as required
- Assisting with removal of recyclable materials within Coach House or basement
- General maintenance for space signage
- Re-stocking donated personal hygiene items as necessary for unreceived orders
- Ensuring the processing of donated gift cards as per agency policy and procedure
- Ensuring that the emergency walkways are free of any stored items or debris.
- Sorting and preparing items that are to be donated to an outside agency
- Communicate inventory levels of donated items to delegated My Sisters' Place staff for the purposes of determining need for public asks
- Sorting incoming donations and stocking all items onto appropriate storage shelving
- General cleaning regiment (i.e. sweeping of floors somewhat regularly

For Micro Enterprise Specifically:

- Take apart donated jewelry, sort and put away.
- Assist women in their final presentation of sales tags and inventory
- Assist with Quality Control
- Help organize cupboards and shelves.

Required Qualifications:

- Current & Clear Vulnerable Person's Sector Check.
- Minimum of 18yrs old age
- 2 written references with contact (1 professional)
- Minimum commitment of 6months

- Strong, demonstrated ability to organize space and inventory, and mobilize others
- Reliability and punctuality
- Ability to handle stress and conflict in a calm manner
- Current WHMIS training which will be offered at the commencement of the position, as well as ongoing trainings which will be offered

Physical and Mental Requirements:

- Must be able to stand for a few hours at a time.
- Must be able to lift up to 20 lbs
- Must be able to climb stairs
